Vehicle Requirements	All vehicles will require a working headlight and taillight for this event. Vehicles must use these lights when moving after dark – except out on the test courses. Vehicles will be checked for safety prior to competition – including the lighting requirements. General Requirements for Cars & Drivers Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Winter Tread, Bar-Tread, Mud/Snow pattern and Hand-cut pattern tyres are prohibited. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.												
Apparel	All apparel including helmet (for drivers of specials) shall comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.												
Classes / Categories	As per current Group5 Series Rules.												
Document Verification and Vehicle Scrutiny	Verification of relevant CAMS licence and current CAMS Car Club Membership will be required at event check in. Vehicle scrutiny will be undertaken on all competing vehicles between 12Noon and 5:45pm Drivers of vehicles with a log book must present that log book to the scrutineer.												
Event Conditions	Tests <i>may</i> consist of current test from the CAMS Motorkhana Test Booklet except test dimensions may be varied from the specified minima and tests may be set up in a mirror image and/or run in the opposite direction. Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, plus any penalties.												
Event Schedule	Competition will commence at approximately 6pm following drivers briefing.												
Other Regulatory Conditions (Awards, restrictions etc)	Awards will be provided in accordance with the current Group5 Series Rules. This event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy. A single passenger is permitted in competing vehicles providing they are over 12yo and have signed the passenger/driver disclaimer form. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Class E: All Wheel Drive Production Vehicles
Class F: Specials / & Non production cars*.
Class J: Juniors under the age of 18 as of the first round of the year.
Class L: Ladies
Juniors and Ladies will be scored on the basis of handicap factors for each class. Handicap factors are as follows:
Class A: 0.94 Class B: 0.90 Class C: 0.92
Class D: 0.86 Class E: 0.94 Class F: 1

- the risks associated with attending or participating in Motor Sport Activities include but are **NOT LIMITED** to the risk that I may suffer harm as a result of:
- to release CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
- motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property;
- others participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
- high levels of noise exposure;
- acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
- the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, I agree:

- to release CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
 - a) my **death**;
 - b) any **physical or mental injury** (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - c) the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a **disease**;
 - d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other **condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs**:
 - i. that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
 - ii. that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community, howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;
- to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities at my own risk.
- I understand that:
 - nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of the Entities as the supplier of the Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
 - nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
 - nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
 - nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
 - CAMS has arranged some limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities. However, I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by CAMS may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account CAMS insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.

WARNING APPLICABLE IN RELATION TO MOTOR SPORT ACTIVITIES HELD IN VICTORIA - WARNING UNDER THE AUSTRALIAN CONSUMER LAW AND FAIR TRADING ACT 2012: Under the Australian Consumer Law (Victoria), several statutory guarantees apply to the supply of certain goods and services. These guarantees mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you:

- are rendered with due care and skill;
- are reasonably fit for any purpose which you either expressly or by implication, make known to the supplier; and
- might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 22 of the **Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic)**, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the **Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012** if you are killed or injured because the services were not in accordance with these guarantees, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. - d. "Motor Sport Activities" means any motor sport activities or Recreational Services which are permitted or approved which CAMS regulates or administers by CAMS or otherwise under the responsibility / control of CAMS;
- e. "Reckless Conduct" means conduct where the supplier of the recreational services is aware, or should reasonably have been aware, of a significant risk that the conduct could result in personal injury to another person and engages in the conduct despite the risk and without adequate justification;
- f. "Recreational Services" means (unless otherwise defined in this document) services that consist of participation in:
 - a) a sporting activity; or
 - b) a similar leisure time pursuit or any other activity that:
 - (i) involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and
 - (ii) is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.
